

## High School Credits from HLS Anderson

Subject	Required Credits	HLS Anderson High School Level Courses (Logic II through Rhetoric IV – five years)	Possible HLS Credits
Math	4	Algebra 1, Geometry, Algebra 2, Pre-Calculus, Advanced Math	5
Science	4	Physical Science, Biology, Chemistry, Physics, Advanced Science	5
Literature & Composition	4	Five years of literature and composition courses including American & British literature and Common Topic through Senior Thesis	5
Social Studies	4	Geography III, American Republic, U.S. History (1), Government (.5), Economics (.5), and World History	5
P.E.	1	none at HLS, but 120 hours of physical activity can be logged for this credit	0
Computer	1	none at HLS, but this course can easily be completed in 1 semester at home	0
Language	2	Five years of Latin	5
Fine Arts	1	Understanding Music; Art, Architecture, & Sculpture; or Fine Arts courses. 120 hours of music instruction/practice can also be logged for this credit.	7
Electives	3	There are numerous choices at HLS that can fulfill this requirement, including Classical Studies and Logic courses.	8

### Notes:

- ❖ In SC, the four core subjects of Math, Science, English (Literature and Composition), and Social Studies are required every year for homeschooling, regardless of how many credits a student has earned in each of those subject areas.
- ❖ High school credits can be earned in 8<sup>th</sup> grade. At HLS, the entire Logic II course offering can be counted for 9<sup>th</sup> grade.
- ❖ SC operates on a mandatory 10 point grading scale for homeschooling (ex. 90-100 is an A).
- ❖ A syllabus must be submitted to receive Honors credit for a course. Honors classes and Dual Enrollment classes carry more weight for GPA. Honors weighting cannot be earned in a foreign language until level 3.
