- History/Classics (Students take both)
  - Book of the Ancient Greeks
  - Greek Epics: Iliad and Odyssey
- Christian Studies: Book of the Ancient World
- Literature: Beowulf the Warrior; Sir Gawain and the Green Knight; The Hound of the Baskervilles; A Midsummer Night's Dream; The Bard of Avon; British Tradition I: Poetry, Prose, and Drama
